EVERYTHING YOUR TEAM NEEDS

All scheduled match courts and finals-day play; match balls and loan rackets; six company-branded team shirts; drinking water; an opening-day rules briefing and warm-up clinic; an on-site league coordinator and roving referee; fixture management and weekly standings; selected match photography and a season highlights gallery; finals-day mixer, refreshments and awards.

A SEASON WITH MOMENTUM

Month 1 / Weeks 1-4: Meet the league, find your pairs and play your first four fixtures.

Month 2 / Weeks 5-8: Build chemistry and climb the table through four more fixtures.

Month 3 / Weeks 9-12: Complete the round robin in weeks 9-11. Week 12 brings the top-four playoffs and placement matches for everyone else.

AED 9,500 IN TEAM SPORTS VOUCHERS

Champions: AED 5,000 in vouchers, the league trophy and medals.

Runners-up: AED 2,500 in vouchers and medals.

Third place: AED 1,000 in vouchers and medals.

Fair Play Award: AED 1,000 in vouchers, selected by the league referee for sportsmanship across the season. Voucher supplier and redemption terms will be confirmed before payment. No cash alternative.

A HOME COURT IN AL QUOZ

Planned venue: **Rally Padel Club**, 21b Street, Al Quoz Industrial 3, Dubai. The club describes indoor courts and an on-site cafe. Court availability and the league booking remain unconfirmed. Venue information: therallyclub.ae.

Price includes applicable taxes. Planned payment: 50% after the schedule and venue are confirmed; 50% seven days before opening day. No payment is due while dates and venue are unconfirmed. A confirmed season cancelled by the organiser before launch receives a full refund.

GOOD COMPETITION. CLEAR GROUND RULES.

01 / YOUR BADGE IS YOUR TICKET

One team per company. Register 4–6 adults aged 18+. Every player must be a current employee of that company throughout the season, verified by a company email and HR confirmation. No guests or external substitutes. No paid padel coaches or professional tour players active in the previous 12 months. Any gender combination is welcome.

02 / FOUR PLAYERS. TWO DOUBLES MATCHES.

Name four eligible employees for each Sunday. Two pairs play two separate doubles matches against the same company. A player cannot play both matches in that fixture. Rotate freely within your registered squad between weeks. The squad locks at the start of week 2; later replacements require verified employment and organiser approval.

03 / HOW A MATCH IS WON

Each match is one set to six games, with a seven-point tiebreak at 6–6 (win by two). Golden point at 40–all; the receiving pair chooses the receiver. Allow five minutes of warm-up and 55 minutes of play. At the time limit, finish the game: the games leader wins; if tied, play a seven-point tiebreak. The referee records the final score.

04 / THE TABLE AND FINALS

Each doubles win earns one league point: 2–0 gives two points; 1–1 gives each company one point. Play all 11 other companies once in weeks 1–11. Ranking ties use head-to-head points among tied teams, overall game difference, games won, then a supervised draw. Week 12: 1st v 4th and 2nd v 3rd semifinals, then championship and bronze finals. Teams 5–12 play 5v6, 7v8, 9v10 and 11v12. A 1–1 knockout or placement tie is settled by a seven-point doubles tiebreak, win by two, with one pair from each team's four players.

05 / TURN UP. PLAY FAIR.

Arrive 15 minutes early. A pair more than 15 minutes late forfeits its match 0–6; an ineligible player causes the affected match to be forfeited. Disputes go to the league referee on the day. Respect opponents, staff and facilities. Wear non-marking shoes. Organiser-led disruptions move to a replacement Sunday; there is no automatic postponement for team absences.
